Dear Parent / Carer.

I hope your child has settled into the new term well and enjoyed their first week of learning.

As you know, we are currently running a two week timetable. This has necessitated some changes to our homework timetable. You can find a copy of our new homework timetable attached to this letter and also on our website.

Home learning forms an important part of our approach to teaching and learning at the academy. International research and our own experience tell us that homework has a positive impact on students' learning and plays an important role in developing independent study skills.

In line with research evidence on effective home learning, homework tasks at the academy are designed to consolidate learning, deepen understanding and prepare students for work to come. A number of home learning tasks this term will include self-quizzing. This involves a student using a knowledge organiser to test their own knowledge and understanding of topics already covered in class. Your child will receive some training on how to do this during form tutor sessions this term.

We would really appreciate your help in supporting your child with their home learning. You do not need to be a subject expert to do this! Some of the best ways that you can help are the most simple and include:

- ensuring your child has a quiet and focused place to work
- helping them to plan their time, including healthy breaks
- talking to your child about what they have been learning
- asking questions to help them test their knowledge (you can use the knowledge organisers available on our website to help with this)
- praising and encouraging your child

HOME LEARNING

West Lakes Academy recognises the positive impact that homework can have on students' **learning** as indicated by research findings published on the EEF's Toolkit website. We also recognise the important role homework can have in promoting **independent** study skills. As such, all students at West Lakes Academy can expect to receive regular homework tasks.

Homework tasks at the academy are designed to **consolidate learning**, **deepen understanding** and **prepare students for work to come**. They are always planned to meet the students' **learning needs** and are always age appropriate.

Deadlines

Students are always given at least six days to complete any homework task. This affords students the opportunity to spread their work across the week, and to avoid days when they may have other commitments (for example sporting activities).

Recording

All homework tasks are set through Edulink. This programme, accessible through any device with internet access, enables parents, carers and students to see a record of homework tasks set. It also clearly displays deadlines, helping students to organise their homework schedule. Staff must inform students when homework has been set on Edulink.

Feedback

Students will receive feedback on their homework in line with the academy's feedback guidelines.

Sanctions for Non-completion of Homework

Students failing to complete a homework task on time, or not completing a task to an acceptable standard, will be sanctioned in line with our homework sanction ladder.
