November ppe exams	Questions/topics were used from 2018 and 2019 exams where grade boundaries were averaged across the papers. Two papers used For Paper 1the whole paper was used three topics covered for physical geography. For paper 2 two human topics were tested, Changing cities (year 9) and global development (year 10) largely lockdown work.

History

Evidence	How will this inform final grade?
November PPE examinations	This will be our starting point as a department. This will provide evidence for a students minimum grade. All students sat two full exam papers in November 2020 and covered approx. 2/3rds of the entire course. Additionally, the paper was standardised and scripts were moderated by three members of staff who are all trained Pearson assessors for the new 9-1 History GCSE. Therefore the PPE was rigorous and the data collected is robust.
April Summative assessment	This will be seen as a final chance for students to demonstrate their understanding of all content, concepts and assessment objectives studied in class throughout their GCSE studies. This assessment will be made up of 76 raw marks and include several relevant question stems and all assessment objectives of the GCSE course. Additionally, this paper will be standardised and all scripts will be moderated by three members of staff who are all trained Pearson assessors for the new 9-1 History GCSE.
Aggregated Past Paper Questions	These will be used as supplementary pieces of evidence to demonstrate the GCSE grade of a student. These will be used to solidify/confirm the grade awarded from the November PPE and April summative assessment. These will be taken from a bank of Pearson verified exam questions and will be marked by three members of staff who are all trained Pearson assessors for the new 9-1 History GCSE. These questions will cover an array content and all of the relevant assessment objectives.

Maths

Evidence	How will this inform final grade?
Nov PPE	Use of external grade boundaries. This will give an initial grade but will be weighted lower than the internal assessment due to them having covered less content at the time of sitting.
Internal assessment	We will create grade boundaries using the information released by the exam board on the average scores gained at each grade for similar questions. These will demonstrate attainment in close to exam conditions in a wide range of topics spanning the relevant grade ranges for each assessment (Higher and Foundation) and include the appropriate proportions of Ao1, Ao2 and Ao3. These will include cross over questions to ensure we have overlap between the Higher and Foundation assessments for accurate grading.
Hegarty maths tasks	All students have been given a set list of tasks appropriate for their exam entry (Higher or Foundation) Staff have refined this list to essential tasks for their group to give evidence of students being able to access topics and complete a range of questions within this topic. We have used exam board exemplar material to decide what grades these tasks represent based on 80%+ demonstrating security within that topic and type of question.

Aggregated assessments March-April 2021 6 mini assessments being sat in lesson	Pupils sat P1 and P3 from Nov 2020 synergy exam paper. Questions on content not being assessed were removed, the remainder were split into 6 mini tests. All tests completed will have the scores combined and the % grade boundaries from AQA 2020 used to give 2 grades.
Exam board provided materials sat in April - May 2021	Pupils sat the following tests provided by AQA from the combined science trilogy resources (synergy resources were reviewed but the topic tests mismatched what our pupils had been taught. They would not have produced enough assessment marks to make valid judgements).
